SCHOLARSHIPS

At the Bradford Family YMCA, individuals will not be turned away due to their inability to pay program and membership fees. The YMCA maintains a generous scholarship program for youth, adults, and families who demonstrate financial need. A.W.A.Y. PROGRAM — Always Welcome At YMCAs

GUEST POLICY/FEEES

Members are encouraged to introduce the YMCA to others. Each member may bring a maximum of two guests per visit, free of charge. Each guest must sign in at the front desk and is permitted three visits per year. After three visits, the guest will be invited to join the YMCA. All guests must provide a photo ID.

2-DAY MEMBERSHIPS

Visitors may purchase a 2-day membership which entitles them to use all of the Y's facilities throughout the day. Youth: \$10, Adult: \$10, Family: \$15. Please call ahead for scheduled activities. All guests must provide a photo ID.

MEMBERSHIP CARD PROCEDURE

All members receive a new membership card when joining the YMCA and are required to bring it each time they use the facility. These ID cards also double as access cards to enter into the facility. Replacement/duplicate cards can be purchased for a fee of \$3.00.

YOUTH POLICY

Youth age 10 and under must have a parent with them in the building after 5:00 PM unless enrolled in a program.
